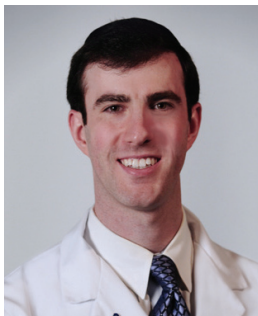

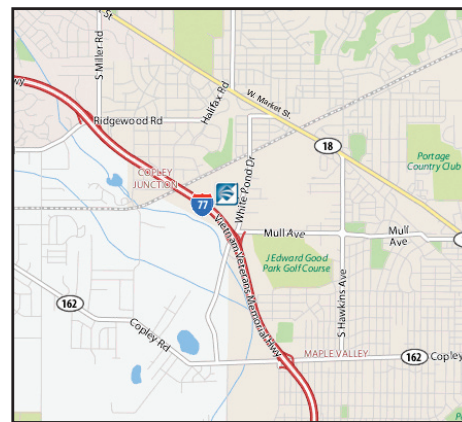
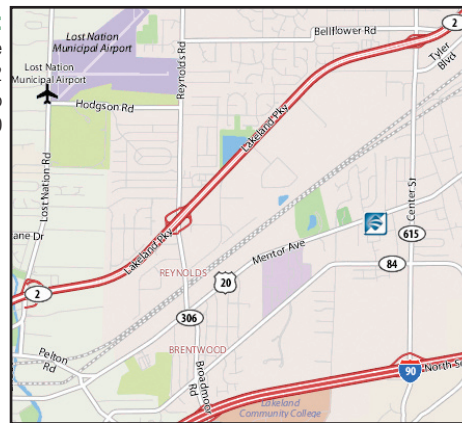

Hemorrhoids are one of the most common medical conditions affecting humanity. Millions of people suffer each day from the pain and embarrassment of hemorrhoids - and often do so for years on end. Internal hemorrhoids are actually derived from normal anatomical structures called anal cushions. They are located just inside the anal canal, and help to prevent the leakage of stool whenever abdominal pressure is increased. If the cushions become stretched out or irritated, they are called hemorrhoids. Factors that often lead to hemorrhoid problems include chronic diarrhea or constipation, strenuous activity, pregnancy, and family history.

The most common symptoms from internal hemorrhoids include bleeding, itching, pain, protrusion of tissue through the rectum, difficulty with anal hygiene, and anal discharge. It is important to remember that there are many other conditions - some of them serious - that can mimic the symptoms of hemorrhoids. If you are experiencing any of the listed symptoms, **do not ignore them!** Be sure to have a physician make a proper diagnosis.

Hemorrhoid symptoms usually begin as mild occasional flare-ups, but if left untreated will often progress until they cause constant, unrelenting aggravation. Early treatment can prevent needless misery.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do your procedures compare to surgery?

It's well known that the traditional hemorrhoid surgery carries with it an excruciatingly painful recovery period, usually lasting about 4 to 6 weeks. In addition, there are a number of complications that can result from surgery, including loss of control for bowel movements. Consequently, most patients would not even consider following up on this type of referral.

In contrast, our procedures are quick, effective, and virtually pain-free. There is no special preparation needed before a treatment, anesthesia is not required during treatment, and there are no restrictions after a treatment. You can leave our office and get right back to enjoying your day! In addition, no serious complications have ever been reported using the methods that we employ.

You say that your methods are quick. How quick?

Extremely. An infrared coagulation treatment usually takes only a few seconds. An Ultroid treatment requires about ten minutes.

How effective are your treatment methods?

Overall, our treatment success rate is about 95%.

Most patients notice an improvement in their symptoms after their very first treatment session, with continued improvement after each subsequent session. A typical treatment course usually requires 4 to 7 sessions staged at 1 to 2 week intervals to achieve maximal improvement of symptoms.

What is your fee for an initial consultation?

There is no charge for the initial consultation with Dr. Gutman to find out more about our procedures and to ask your questions.

Most patients have their first treatment session the same day as the initial consultation.
